BOLD games at home

The Broncos begin the season with a great start going 7-2 against a very difficult schedule. The two losses have been against teams ranked in the top 10 on their home courts, but the Broncos have defeated 3 teams ranked in the preseason top 25 as well. This past week, the team defeated two conference foes to begin the conference schedule at 2-0. The first game of the week saw #13 University of Sioux Falls visit the Broncos, and Hastings got an easy 73-59 win. Hastings College fell behind by as many as thirteen points in the first half but an 11-0 run in the closing minutes gave them a 33-29 halftime advantage. The Lady Broncos used solid defense to hold the sharp-shooting Cougars to just 29% from the field in the second half while knocking down 52% of their own shots. Hastings also shot 90% from the free throw line (18-20) for the game.

Next, the Broncos faced Nebraska Wesleyan in Lincoln and won easily 103-58. The Broncos led early taking a 47-24 lead at half time. They continued to put the points on the board and out scored the Prairie Wolves 56-34 in the second half. The Broncos played tough defense causing 24 turnovers and had 16 steals. The scoring was very even with Rachel Isherwood leading the way with 16 points. Heather McKeon and Becky Tesch each had 14 points. Kim Faimon was very busy as well as she had 13 points, 5 assists to 1 turnover, and 5 steals in only 20 minutes. The team shot 55.7% from the field and 70% from the 3 point line for the game.

The Broncos will now face two non-conference opponents this weekend in Hastings. The first game is against Tabor College who is currently 1-4 on the year. Tabor most recently competed in the Sterling Classic and went 0-2. In the first game, they played York College and got beat 65-45. Tynan Honn led Tabor with 17 pts. The next night, Tabor lost to Mid America Christian 66-57 and Honn was the leading scorer again with 15 points.

Hastings will finish up the weekend against Sterling College who is 3-1 on the year. Sterling is on a 2 game winning streak as they hosted their own classic last week. They beat Mid America Christian 73-56 with Megan Patrick as the leading scorer with 20 points. The next night they played York College and won 84-63. Megan Patrick led the team once again with 25 points on the evening.
