Hastings Bounces back with 7-0 Win

The Lady Broncos travelled to Sioux City on Saturday and matched up against Briar Cliff. After a disappointing loss to Doane last week, the team bounced back in a big way and came away with an easy 7-0 win. The scoring occurred early and often as all seven goals were scored within the first 55 minutes of the game. Davonne Holland got things started in the 4th minute off an assist from Allison Kotschwar. Just seven minutes later, Jesse Herse scored off an assist from Holland. Then it became the Carlson show. Jessica Carlson scored the next 3 goals in the 17th, 22nd, and 28th minute with two assists from Kotschwar and an assist from Wenzl. This made the score 5-0. The Lady Broncos finished the game with goals from Wenzl (49th) and Kotschwar (55th). Several of the players had big games, but none bigger than Kotschwar. She had 3 assists and a goal. Coach Flogaites had this to say about the game. "We were fortunate to have a strong start against a well organized and well coached squad. We were absolutely lethal in terms of finishing, which is what I sensed what was coming on in the 2nd half in the Doane match. It was our 10th shutout so in that sense we are beyond elated. Mental lapses and concentration mistakes are what causes defeat at this stage of the season, and I was as pleased to see us maintain the clean sheet as I was to see the finishing."

The Lady Broncos now will face Morningside on Saturday, October 31st in Hastings. Morningside sits 11th in the current GPAC standings while the Lady Broncos sit 4th. Also, it is senior day for the Lady Broncos. Coach Flogaites has this to say about the match. "Tom Maxon is a great coach, super colleague and he will bring a determined and organized squad to play us on Halloween. It will be a match of trick or treat. Treat if we score and trick if we collapse with silly mental mistakes and a lack of care for the futbol itself. It is senior day and we have a lot to play for in terms of honoring our seniors who have been staggering in terms of their contribution to the squad. I couldn't hand select better players to help build this program. I'm incredibly proud of them, and they are fantastic human beings above and away from the futbol. We are going to chase our 12th win as hard as we can, as this potential win would secure us a home match for the 1st round of the GPAC conference tournament. Futbol is about what you have inside of you, and if you've got the guts to stare that in the face, look it dead, and move onto being a better human being. I think we are willing to do that, so here's yet another chance to find out. You've got to love that proposition.
