Lady Broncos Travelled to Arizona

The women's soccer team headed out to Prescott, Arizona to play in the Embry-Riddle Classic. The team played some tough competition and ended with a split of the two games. In the first game, they played San Diego Christian and came away with a 2-0 win. The goals were scored by Jessica Carlson and Jesse Herse.

The Lady Broncos turned around the next day and played the host school, Embry- Riddle. The team had to deal with the weather as it rained on and off the entire game. The team battled but did not have enough and lost 1-0. The lone goal came off a corner kick in the 15th minute. The Lady Broncos pressed but could not find the goal. It was the first loss of the season.

The Lady Broncos then played Jamestown for the fourth game in six days. Even after a long trip from Arizona the previous day, there was no let up from the team. The Lady Broncos blasted the Jimmies 6-0. They started fast when Jesse Herse made a nice pass to Shannon Buttner who finished in the 3rd minute. The team looked a little sluggish the rest of the half and could not score, even with a strong wind at their back. Coach Flogaites woke them up at half time and the Lady Broncos came out fired up. The first minute of the second half saw Jessica Carlson score her first of three goals (46th, 51st, 81st min.) on the day. She was assisted by Jesse Herse on her first goal. Carlson's second goal was created by a nice cross by Casey Freisen that Carlson cut back and blasted the ball into the net. In the 52nd minute, Davonne Holland scored her first career goal as Allison Kotschwar made a beautiful through pass that Davonne settled quickly and knocked it by the keeper. Jesse Herse then got in the scoring action as she scored her third goal on the season. She placed a 20 yard shot just over the outreached hands of the keeper. The scoring finished on Carlson's third goal of the day when her and Jessalyn Barton played a very nice give and go combination. The defense again did a nice job as Tenaya Howdson made her first start at keeper.
