Impact on P-12 Learning* When asked "How would you rate his/her impact on student learning?"Ninety-two (92%) of principals responding to a survey rated first year teachers prepared at Hastings College as moderately or highly effective.	Indicators of Teaching Effectiveness* Teachers in their first year of teaching in 2018-2019 were rated by principals as being effective. On survey items related to content knowledge, planning, and assessment, means fell between 3.35 and 3.75 on a 4 point scale.	Satisfaction of employers and employment milestones* 100% of principals responding to a spring 2019 survey indicated the intent to rehire the Hastings College-prepared first year teacher.
