Impact on P-12 Learning* Fifty-three (53%) of principals responded to a spring 2020 NDE survey (response rate was down during the pandemic) of first-year Hastings College prepared teachers. Of those responding, all but one identified the teacher as "highly effective" or "moderately effective" in their impact on student learning.	Indicators of Teaching Effectiveness* Teachers in their first year of teaching in 2019-2020 were rated by principals as being effective. On survey items related to learning environments, planning for instruction, and leadership and collaboration, principals means fell between 3.29 and 3.5 on a 4-point scale.
